LAUNCH OF NEW "POLICE 2 CITIZEN" WEBSITE**

The Village of Oak Lawn is proud to announce the launch of its new "Police 2 Citizen" or P2C website. The main purpose of the site is to provide up to date public access to Police Records of reported incidents. Information regarding arrests will also be available along with Arrest Photos. The website (<http://www.oaklawnecomm.org/p2c>) is shared with the Police Departments of Bridgeview, Burbank, and Evergreen Park as well as the Oak Lawn Emergency Communications Division. Other items available on the site include:

- The public will be able to map reported incidents from the **Event Search** Button.
- **Warrant** Info will list our active local Warrants.
- **Sex Offender** Info will allow them to search for Sex Offenders from any of the 4 towns. It will also give them a link to the County and State Sex Offender sites.
- **Jail Inmates** links them to County & State links regarding persons in custody in the County or State system not locally.
- **Bike Registration** allows Citizens to log their Bike information into our data base.
- **Community Calendar** lists information about upcoming events.
- **Traffic Conditions** shows active calls that may affect travel in town. (Accidents, Traffic Control etc.).
- **Officer/Dispatch Commendation** allows citizens the opportunity to advise of good service from our employees.
- **Current Weather** links to a Weather website for local forecasts and current conditions.
- **Press Releases.**

There are also links back to the Village Websites of the participating agencies and to the Emergency Notification service **Everbridge**.

This national take-back initiative will provide a unified opportunity for the public to surrender pharmaceutical controlled substances and other medications to law enforcement officers for destruction.

**What will be accepted:**

- Controlled, non-controlled, and over the counter substances will be collected.
- All solid dosage pharmaceutical products in consumer containers may be accepted. Liquid products, such as cough syrup, should remain sealed in their original container. The depositor should ensure that the cap is tightly sealed to prevent leakage.

**What will not be accepted:**

- Intra-venous solutions, injectibles, and syringes will not be accepted due to potential hazard posed by blood-borne pathogens.
- Illicit substances such as marijuana, cocaine or methamphetamine are not a part of this initiative and should not be placed in collection containers.
