Our Oak Lawn community, working together, can get pest-related problems under control.

Some simple steps to get rid of rodents:

- Eliminate **all** bird feeders and never feed wildlife. Healthy animals will find their own food and feeding these animals is not legal.
- Clean up after pets **DAILY**.
- Keep pet food in covered containers only.
- Keep grass cut and bushes trimmed to eliminate comfortable nesting areas.
- Pick up and discard fallen fruits from trees and excess vegetables from gardens.
- Eliminate any debris in yards and landscaping.
- Garbage containers must be in good condition and kept closed.
- All firewood must be elevated at least 4 inches off the ground.
- Keep porches, decks and garages tidy to avoid critter hiding places.
- Check your property for any areas that would be conducive for a rodent to hide and therefore breed.



If you have a rodent problem or have concerns about the condition of another property, please contact me at 708-499-7820. Inspectors will check the properties in question and send a warning to the homeowner. Then our exterminator can check the property and bait accordingly.
