**By working together, the Oak Lawn community
can get pest-related problems under control.**



- Eliminate **all** bird feeders and never feed wildlife; healthy animals will find their own food
- Clean up after pets **DAILY** – pet feces is a source of food for rodents
- Do not leave pet feeding bowls outside unattended
- Keep grass cut and bushes trimmed to eliminate comfortable nesting areas
- Pick-up and discard fallen fruit from trees and excess vegetables from gardens
- Eliminate any debris in your yard and landscaping
- Garbage containers must be in good condition and lids kept closed
- All firewood must be elevated at least 4 inches off the ground
- Keep porches, decks and garages tidy to avoid critter hiding places
- Check your property for any areas that would be conducive for rodents to hide and breed



If you have observed rodent activity on your property, please call the Property Maintenance Department. We can schedule our exterminator to check the exterior of your property and bait accordingly.
