### **VILLAGE OF OAK LAWN 2012: 1st HALF FINANCIAL UPDATE**

Although there still seems to be a significant amount of disagreement and uncertainty regarding the American economic outlook, the Village's operating revenues through the first half of the year which ended June 30<sup>th</sup> were \$28.1 million and are tracking budget revenues fairly well at approximately 55% of the municipal budget of \$50.7 million. Sales tax revenue thru the first half of the year of \$6.2 million reflect an economy on the upswing, is above the budgeted figure by approximately \$80,000, and exceeds last year's pace by \$100,000. Despite the State of Illinois' budget woes and the ongoing negative cash flow impact on the Village's operations, some progress has been made during the first half of 2012 as the Village received over \$3 million of state income tax payments as compared to budgeted state tax receipts of \$4.6 million for the year. The Village's administration is still concerned that the State's ongoing financial problems may delay these tax payments which are critical to the Village's ability to continue providing quality services to residents. The Village's fee income from licenses, permits and other sources of revenue thru the first six months of the year was \$5.1 million and represented 49% of the budgeted figure of \$10.4 million, just slightly behind the budget for the year.

Finally, the Village's actual operating expenses for the first half of the year were \$26.0 million or approximately \$1 million under the municipal budget of \$26.9 million projected thru the end of June.

**U.S. NEWS RANKS**

**Christ Medical Center Among Top Hospitals**

Advocate Christ Medical Center, the state's leader for open heart surgery, has been recognized as being among the top hospitals in the nation for cardiology and heart surgery, and for geriatric medicine, according to the "Best Hospitals 2012-13" rankings released today (July 17) by *U.S. News and World Report*. Fewer than 150 of the estimated 5,000 hospitals in the country achieved national ranking in at least one of 16 clinical specialties measured by the publication.

The medical center also was rated fourth overall among hospitals in the Chicago metropolitan area and the entire state of Illinois and cited as a "high performer" in 10 other clinical areas: cancer; diabetes and endocrinology; treatment of ear, nose and throat disorders; gastroenterology; gynecology; nephrology; neurology and neurosurgery; orthopedics; pulmonology; and urology.

The announcement of the *U.S. News* rankings follows Christ Medical Center's selection earlier this year to *Thompson Reuters* 2012 list of 100 Top Hospitals.

LEMONT, IL, July 19, 2012 - Abide in Me presents, CELEBRATE ME HOME, a benefit supporting adults with disabilities from Garden Center Services. The benefit, featuring live entertainment, a silent auction, and raffles will be held on Saturday, September 8, 2012 from 3:00 p.m. -8:00 p.m. at 115 Bourbon Street in Merrionette Park, IL. All proceeds from the benefit will be allocated to relieving the costs for purchasing, adapting, and maintaining and all-accessible home for a group of women with disabilities and supporting the initiative to allow individuals with developmental disabilities to move from larger, residential facilities to smaller, community-based homes in the state of Illinois.

Contributions to Celebrate Me Home will provide Jamee Fiedler, daughter of Robert and Colleen Fiedler (Lemont, IL), and other Garden Center Services residents, the ability to live in a smaller, community-based home where they will receive personalized and consistent care, opportunities to be actively involved within their community, and the chance to live as independently as they are able. Jamee was diagnosed with cerebral palsy, multiple physical disabilities, and an intellectual disability as a toddler. At twenty-one years old, she uses a wheel chair to ambulate, speaks verbally in short phrases, and uses a communication device for longer thoughts. Jamee has never been defined by her limitations, but rather by her incredible ability to make people smile, laugh, and enjoy her company. Jamee is a graduate of Elim Christian School (Palos Heights, IL), and currently lives at an Intermediate Care Facility for the Developmentally Disabled (ICF/DD) and attends day programming through Garden Center Services (Burbank, IL). At her residential facility, Jamee lives with fifteen men and women of all ages who have significantly varying needs and supports. Living as independent, active members of their community is difficult for Jamee and her peers due to the lack of funding and types of accessible housing currently available to individuals with developmental disabilities within the state of Illinois.

Abide in Me is proud to partner with Garden Center Services, a multi-program agency which supports over 150 adults with disabilities in a multitude of ways including: living environments, vocational day programs, and employment opportunities within the community.
