BOARD OF TRUSTEES UNANIMOUSLY APPROVES ZONING FOR ADVOCATE EXPANSION PHASE II

On Tuesday, September 4, 2012, the Village of Oak Lawn Board of Trustees unanimously approved the zoning for Advocate Christ Medical Center's Phase II Expansion. Through hard work, the Village and Advocate have addressed and will continue to work together regarding critical community issues such as employee parking lot landscaping; oxygen tank screening/buffering; traffic calming along 93rd Street; Advocate's commitment to 95th Street Medians; cross walks; a new traffic signal at Kilbourn Avenue or a Kolmar Avenue realignment; campus lighting; Kostner Avenue sidewalks and cross section; and campus gateway signage and way finding.

Advocate's Phase II Expansion Program consists of the following:

A 9-story Inpatient Tower located on the west side of Kostner Avenue near 94th Street, where the existing parking garage will be demolished.

An Inpatient Parking Garage that will serve the Inpatient Tower through an elevated pedestrian bridge.

A number of cross walk, streetscape and landscape improvements throughout the campus to improve pedestrian traffic flow.

Advocate is currently constructing and near completion of the following buildings as part of their Phase I Expansion Program:

A 9-story Outpatient Pavilion located at the northeast corner of 95th of Kilbourn Avenue.

An Outpatient Parking Garage located at the northwest corner of 95th and Kilbourn Avenue that will serve the Outpatient Pavilion through an elevated pedestrian bridge.

A Hope Parking Garage located at the southeast corner of 93rd and Kostner Avenue to serve the Hope Hospital.

When is pick-up?

Pickup is scheduled weekly (refuse, recycling and yard waste) on designated days.

- Materials should be placed no earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day prior to your scheduled pickup.
- Materials must be placed at the curb no later than 5:30 a.m. day of pickup.

What goes in containers?

Blue Toter: Garbage

Green Toter: Recyclables

Brown Toter: Yard Waste

What are the costs?

Monthly cost for pickup: \$17.81 Non-Senior \$16.50 Senior

How do I get replacement of damaged or worn toters?

Contact Republic Services for the garbage and recycling toter. Contact the Village for the yard waste toter.

How do you dispose of dead animals in the street?

Dead animals pickup in the R.O.W. can be called into Republic Services. All others must be bagged and placed in your garbage.

How do I dispose of bulk items or “problem” items?

(i.e.: chair, sofa, mattress, carpeting, appliances, white goods, and tires)

- Carpeting must be cut in 4 ft. lengths (rolled and tied)
- One bulk item may be placed out for collection per week.
- The bulk item will be collected later in the day by a separate truck, after reported by the driver.

How do I dispose of electronics?

Electronics can be dropped off at the Village E-Waste site. Or contact Republic Services Customer Service Department at 708-385-8252.

How do you dispose of paint?

- Latex Paint that is dry can be picked up curbside.
- All oil or lead based paint requires disposal at Household Hazardous Waste drop off sites.

What materials are not accepted?

- Auto parts, large construction waste, swimming pools, decks, sheds, chemicals, wet paints, household hazardous waste, drums, etc. or materials not in containers other than described above

Will my service day remain the same with Republic Services?

- You will be picked up on the same day that you are currently receiving service.
- But it might be at a different time of day so it is important that your toters are at the pick-up point before 5:30 a.m. and they will be service during that day.

What should we do if we have a special situation that needs special service or attention?



"MY THOUGHTS BE BLOODY" BOOK DISCUSSION



"ABRAHAM LINCOLN: SELF-MADE IN AMERICA" TRAVELING EXHIBIT


