VILLAGE REVENUES STRONG FROM RECYCLING EFFORTS

Thanks to all of you who recycle, the Village has collected \$139,000 through the end of the August in what will be one of our best revenue years ever for recycling proceeds. The Village of Oak Lawn has an agreement in place with our waste services provider, Veolia Environmental, whereby the Village receives 50% of the revenues collected from the recycling proceeds. With commodity prices high, there is a premium on recycling products these days and everyone is encouraged to keep up the good work. The highest revenue number in recent years was \$190,000 in 2008. We have a few more months to see if we can hit a new records, so fill up those green toters.


