H1N1 VACCINE

The Village and the Cook County Department of Public Health are working together to offer H1N1 shots to students who are enrolled in all Oak Lawn schools (Grades K-12).

All other persons should seek H1N1 vaccinations from their Primary Care physician or make an appointment at one of the Cook County Department of Public Health Clinics. Information about these clinics is below.

Persons who are seeking the H1N1 Vaccine and who are in one of the following priority groups can call for an appointment to receive the vaccination:

- all pregnant women
- caretakers and household contacts of children under 6 months of age
- healthcare and emergency medical services employees
- individuals 6 months to 24 years of age
- individuals 25 to 64 years of age with underlying medical conditions, such as asthma or diabetes, that put them at high risk for flu-related complications

Effective immediately, and until further notice, residents may call 708.836.8600 or one of the CCDPH District phone numbers listed below to make an appointment to receive the H1N1 vaccine. Appointment lines are open Mondays through Fridays, 8:30 am until 4:30 pm. CCDPHD staff will schedule appointment time and location for residents.



The Power of Pomegranate

Pomegranates are low in calories and high in nutrition. They have an abundance of antioxidants and phytochemicals. In an article published in the November 2009 issue of *Life Extension* magazine, the author gives explanations as to why this fruit/juice is helpful in the fight against many degenerative diseases.
