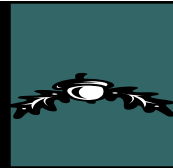

Village Clerk Jane M. Quinlan has initiated a new program wherein she will go out to several locations in the community to make it easier for residents to register to vote. "I think it's important that we don't force people to always have to come to Village Hall for their needs," she said. "People have very busy lives and we should make every effort to bring these services out into the neighborhoods to help them out."

Clerk Quinlan will be registering voters at several locations over the next few weeks in preparation for the February 5, 2008 presidential primary. **Senior Bus** is available to Oak Lawn residents with disabilities and Senior Citizens. Applications are available at the Village Hall, the Senior Center or by calling (708) 499-7820. Qualifying residents are allowed one round trip anywhere in Oak Lawn or to Chicago Ridge Mall. The bus runs on Monday, Thursday and Friday from 8:00 am until 3:30 pm. Reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance between 8:00 am and 12:00 Noon on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.
