Village Passes 2010 Budget

The 2010 Budget was passed at a Special Meeting of the Village Board on December 14, 2009. The total budgeted expenditures including all funds are \$99,718,923. The break down by fund is as follows:


CHRISTMAS TREE PICKUP JANUARY 2010

- Public Works will be recycling (chipping) live Christmas trees for single family residences Fridays, **January 8th & 15th** (weather permitting)
- If the tree has lights, tinsel or ornaments and is placed curbside with the garbage, Veolia will pickup the tree as regular refuse.
- Residents are encouraged to recycle their live tree by
 - Calling 708-499-7758 or e-mailing* (*see below*)
 - Placing the tree curbside keeping it visible if snowfall should occur
 - Free the tree of tinsel, lights and ornaments

WAYS TO BE "GREEN" DURING THE HOLIDAYS

1. USE TIMERS FOR YOUR INDOOR AND OUTDOOR LIGHTING.
2. GET A FAKE TREE; CHECK FIRST TO SEE WHICH MATERIALS ARE BEST FOR THE EARTH.
3. IF YOU GET A REAL TREE, BE SURE TO PUT IT OUT TO BE RECYCLED THE 2 WEEKS AFTER CHRISTMAS. (See Website for more details...)
4. USE NEWSPAPER OR THE SUNDAY COMICS AS WRAPPING PAPER.
5. RECYCLE WRAPPING PAPER, GIFT BOXES AND TISSUE PAPER. ONLY PAPER WRAPPING PAPER CAN BE RECYCLED. NO LAMINATED PAPER, WRAPPING PAPER WITH GLITTER, FOIL WRAPPING PAPER, RIBBONS, BOWS, STRING, AND PLASTIC WRAP ARE RECYCLABLE.
6. USE GROCERY BAGS MADE FROM RECYCLED MATERIAL AS WRAPPING FOR YOUR CHRISTMAS GIFTS. ASK THE RECIPIENT TO USE THE BAG WHEN SHOPPING.
7. USE SOLAR POWERED OUTDOOR LIGHTS.
8. GIVE OLD CLOTHES AND TOYS TO A NEEDY ORGANIZATION.
9. INSTEAD OF BUYING GIFTS, GIVE A DONATION TO A NEEDY ORGANIZATION.
10. GIVE THE GIFT OF TIME BY VOLUNTEERING.
11. IF YOU GET A GIFT YOU DON'T LIKE, GIVE IT TO A NEEDY ORGANIZATION.
12. CARPPOOL WHEN GOING HOLIDAY SHOPPING AND PLAN YOUR ROUTE TO BE FUEL EFFICIENT.
13. INSTEAD OF DRIVING DOWNTOWN TO GO SHOPPING, TAKE THE OAK LAWN METRA TRAIN WHICH HAS TRAINS RUNNING MONDAY THRU SATURDAY.
14. DO AN INVENTORY OF YOUR PANTRY. IF YOU HAVE EXTRA FOOD, GIVE IT TO A LOCAL FOOD PANTRY.
15. MANY TOYS AND ELECTRONIC GIFTS USE BATTERIES. WHEN THE BATTERIES ARE USED UP, DROP THE DEAD BATTERIES AT ONE OF THE BATTERY COLLECTION BINS AT THE VILLAGE HALL, THE METRA TRAIN STATION OR OAK LAWN PARK DISTRICT FACILITIES.
16. IF YOU GET A NEW CELL PHONE, DONATE YOUR OLD ONE TO THE "CELL PHONES FOR SOLDIERS" AT THE VILLAGE HALL, OAK LAWN LIBRARY OR AN OAK LAWN PARK DISTRICT FACILITY.

- White, colored, glossy paper

CARDBOARD

If your business generates a large quantity of cardboard, bin collection service for separated, flattened corrugated cardboard is available. Contact the Recycling Program.


