## **VILLAGE EXTENDS VEOLIA CONTRACT 6 MONTHS**

At the December 13, 2011 Village Board meeting, the Board agreed to extend the refuse contract of Veolia Environmental Services by six months, to June 30, 2012. The Village will be preparing bid specifications which will be sent out to interested parties. The Board believed that if there was a change in the refuse service provider that it would be less cumbersome for residents during the summer months.

For those interested in purchasing the Brown Leaf Toters, these are on order and expected for delivery before spring. The cost is \$40.

## **VILLAGE CLOSES ON JC PENNEY PROPERTY**

### **AT 111<sup>TH</sup> AND CICERO**

On November 30, 2011, the Village completed the purchase of just over 22 acres of property from JC Penney for \$10.95 million. The purchase will be funded through the tax increment financing district on that site.

The property acquisition is part of the goal for redevelopment of the property. The redevelopment is anticipated to involve mixed-use retail, restaurants, and incorporation of the natural surroundings of the adjacent Wolfe Wildlife wetlands.

The 22 acres comprises two parcels. One is the Kmart, the former Dominick's, and the parking lot east of those buildings. The second is an out lot on 111<sup>th</sup> street where there once was a gas station. The Village currently owns the land immediately north of that out lot, the former Edgar Funeral Home, which is leased out temporarily to Midwest Orthopedic Consultants.

## CITY OF CHICAGO WATER RATE INCREASE HITS OAK LAWN

Please note: Effective with your next billing cycle, there will be an increase in your water rates. This rate increase reflects the cost of providing Lake Michigan water to you safely and efficiently, and is primarily due to the City of Chicago's 25% rate increase for water supplied to the Village of Oak Lawn. The new rates are as follows:

### Residential rates (Quarterly)

- 0 to 10,000 gallons at \$4.698 per 1,000 gallons (minimum charge of \$46.98)
- 10,001 to 30,000 gallons at \$4.798 per 1,000 gallons
- Over 30,000 gallons at \$4.898 per 1,000 gallons

### Non-residential rates (Monthly)

- 0 to 4,000 gallons a minimum charge of \$15.66
- 4,001 to 10,000 gallons at \$4.798 per 1,000 gallons
- Over 10,000 gallons at \$4.898 per 1,000 gallons






