## **OAK LAWN TO HAVE CANDLELIGHT VIGIL FOR NEWTOWN, CONNECTICUT FAMILIES**

**“For 27 Minutes on Thursday,  
December 27, 2012, the Christmas Lights Will Go Dark”**

Oak Lawn will have a candlelight vigil for victims of the Newtown, Connecticut school tragedy on December 27, 2012 at 7:00 p.m. on the Village Green.

The Village will turn off all lights on the Village Green for 27 minutes as families gather in candlelight to remember the 20 children and 7 adults who lost their lives on December 14, 2012 in the Sandy Hook Elementary school and Newtown shootings.

Seeing the faces of those little children, hearing about the teachers, and how hard they fought to protect the children, thinking about the families, Christmas – the pain for them must be unbearable. I have four children 10 and under. I cannot imagine dropping them off for school and one of them not coming home.

By turning off the decorations for 27 minutes we are saying that on Earth, this holiday season has a little less light. By lighting candles we are saying that our families are thinking about theirs - that is so much closer to the true meaning of Christmas.

We invite you and your family to join us on the Village Green as we stop to remember the lives lost in the community of Newtown. We welcome you to bring any cards or letters of support that you may wish to have mailed to Newtown. A collective mailing from one community to another just may provide some comfort in their time of need.

If you are unable to join us, please consider turning off the holiday lights at home at 7:00 PM. for 27 minutes. Together let's send up those prayers. These families need them.
